

Electronic Drop Off and Paper Shredding Events

The Jefferson County Commission provides homeowners within the limits of Jefferson County, Alabama **FREE** opportunities to recycle common household electronics (televisions included) and to shred personal documents. Below is a list of items that will be accepted as well as a list of items that will not be accepted. Event dates, times and locations can be found on www.jccal.org. - Electronic Drop Off Events are for residential items only. We will not accept materials from businesses and contractors.
- Place all materials in the trunk or bed of your vehicle for transporting. Ensure all materials are secured.
- Remain in your vehicles while dropping of materials. For safety, event workers will unload items from your vehicle.
- All paper collected is shredded on site. Papers brought to the event are placed in large bins. When the bins are full the entire contents of the bin are loaded into the hopper and shredded at one time. Because of the volume of traffic and the large amount of paper collected, you are not able to wait for your items to be shredded.
- Be patient with our event workers, some vehicles take more time to unload than others.
