### 3. Case V-22-18: Mountain Brook Dental Care, 3928 Montclair Road

**EXHIBIT 1** 

Mark Williams, Reliable Sign Services, presented the application via Zoom. The applicant is proposing a new wall sign for Mountain Brook Dental Care. The sign will be an aluminum painted sign that will replace the previous Cloud Willis & Ellis sign. The proposed sign is 61.11 square feet in size.

Committee comments:

- Concerned about the aesthetics of the sign as presented.
- This signage could alter future tenant's ability to install their own signage.
- The address number rather than a business name might be a solution.
- Consider background sign color to match the wall behind rather than white.
- Reduce size of sign.
- The committee requests additional information regarding the size of the existing façade sign.

Following the discussion, the Committee made the following recommendations:

- The Committee recommends that the background of the proposed sign is changed from white to a color similar to that of the wall behind it.
- Consider using the address numbers instead of the proposed sign.
- Reduce the size to stay below the maximum allowed for this building of 120 square feet (for all signage).
- Please resubmit for consideration.

### 4. Case V-22-19: Gunn Dermatology, 391 Rele Street

# David Brandt, Fravert Services, represented the applicant. The applicant is proposing new signage for Gunn Dermatology in Lane Parke. The proposed signage package includes 5 signs featuring 3 façade signs, a projecting blade sign and door signage. The total proposed aggregate sign area is 37.39 square feet. A variance is requested to allow the logo height to be above the 16" maximum.

Committee discussion:

- Concerned about the size and placement of the blade sign.
- Door vinyl has a lot of information; consider reducing wording.
- To approve the logo height above 16", a variance will be required.
- For the blade sign to be lighted, a variance will be required. The size is too large. Consider reducing or deleting the blade sign.
- Allowing the signage as presented could set a risky precedence.

Following the discussion, Mrs. Ritchie called for a motion.

## **EXHIBIT 2**

- Motion: Mr. Barrett, motion to approve the signage as presented, with the following exceptions:
  - Reduce the blade sign by one-half; no illumination. Lower the sign position on the building to line up with the window transom.
  - Consider reducing the wording on the door vinyl.
  - The logo may be increased slightly, to a height of 16-20 inches, which is approved by variance.
  - Please forward changes via email for final approval.


# NOTE: GUNN DERMATOLOGY UPDATE


On June 28, 2022, the Committee voted, via email, to approve the amendments submitted for Gunn Dermatology.

The Village Design Review Committee approves the revised signage as presented:

- All three logos on the façade signs enlarged from 16 to 20 inches.
- The letters on the Spa Mountain Brook façade sign enlarged from 11 to 16 inches (letters on the other façade signs remain the same).
- The blade sign reduced from 30"x32" to 22"x23" and lowered into the recommended location.
- Reduced language on the door signage.









1 DETAIL
